1) CLINICAL SUMMARY

- The patient reported a palpable left breast area for approximately 6 weeks.
- Breast imaging performed on 04 March 2026 described an irregular left upper outer quadrant mass measuring approximately 2.2 cm on ultrasound, associated suspicious calcifications, and one mildly abnormal left axillary lymph node.
- No right breast suspicious abnormality was reported in the available imaging summary.

2) RELEVANT INVESTIGATION SUMMARY

- Pre-operative blood testing on 12 March 2026 showed mild microcytic anemia with hemoglobin 11.2 g/dL and mean corpuscular volume 78 fL.
- Alkaline phosphatase was mildly elevated at 128 U/L.
- Kidney function, electrolytes, platelet count, white cell count, and coagulation profile were within stated reference ranges.

3) KEY FINDINGS

- Suspicious left breast mass on imaging.
- Adjacent suspicious calcifications.
- Mildly abnormal left axillary lymph node.
- Mild microcytic anemia.
- Mildly elevated alkaline phosphatase.

4) UNCERTAINTY / MISSING INFORMATION

- No tissue pathology report is included.
- Prior breast imaging is unavailable.
- Family history, genetic risk assessment, medication allergies, pregnancy status, and detailed surgical history are not documented in the supplied packet.
- Complete staging information is not available.

5) REFERRAL QUESTION

- Specialist review requested for interpretation of suspicious imaging findings in the context of available blood results and discussion of appropriate next steps.

6) RECOMMENDED FOLLOW-UP

- Discuss the imaging and laboratory findings with a breast surgeon, oncology specialist, or doctor.
